

Cleaning instructions


Laminate can be cleaned with a soft cloth wrung in a mild solution of lukewarm water and a universal cleaning detergent. For difficult stains, such as coffee or tea, use a nylon bristle brush with mild household cleaner or detergent, rinsing with clean water and repeating as necessary. Always wipe with a soft, dry cloth after cleaning.

Aluminium (powder-coated or polished) can be cleaned using a soft cloth wrung in lukewarm water. Always dry immediately with a soft cloth. Avoid using abrasive cleaning products such as steel wool as this will cause damage to the surface.

Step 1 / 9

Fit the T-Bracket (D) to the top section of the leg (B) using two long button screws (K). The two small holes on each T-Bracket (D) must face upwards as per the illustration.

Important: Make sure to tighten these screws properly to ensure each leg is secure.




NB! Make sure the holes on the corner brackets (C) face upwards.

Step 2 / 9

Insert the T-Brackets (D) into both ends of the central frame (G) as shown, and secure them with a short flat head screw (H) as per the illustration.


Important: Do not completely tighten the screws at this stage.



Step 3 / 9

Insert two long frames (E) into each side of the T-Brackets (D) as shown, and attach them with short flat head screws (H) using an allen key as shown.


Important: Do not completely tighten the screws at this stage.



Step 4 / 9

Insert two corner brackets (C) into the ends of each short frame (F). Secure with short flat head screws (H). The two small holes on the corner brackets (C) must face upwards as per the illustration.


Important: Do not completely tighten the screws at this stage.



NB! Make sure the holes on the corner brackets (C) face upwards.


Step 5 / 9

Place the legs (B) on the frame upside down to align with each corner bracket (C). Secure two long flat head screws (J) into each corner to connect legs and frame as per the illustration.



Step 6 / 9

Insert the installed short frames (F) into both sets of long frames (E). Fasten with four short flat head screws (H) in each end.




Place the cover components (L & M) on each of the six leg brackets and click them into place.

Step 8 / 9

Place both table tops (A) upside down on a soft, flat surface, making sure that the rounded corners are at either end. Place the inverted frame on the table tops and use the short button screws (I) to secure the top to the frame.

Important: Install the screws partially at first and then tighten once all are in place to secure a correct fit.



Step 9 / 9

Finally, double check that all screws are tight and secure. Then flip the table upright and enjoy your product.
