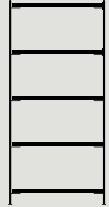

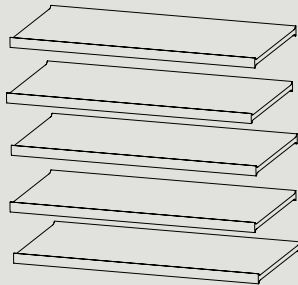

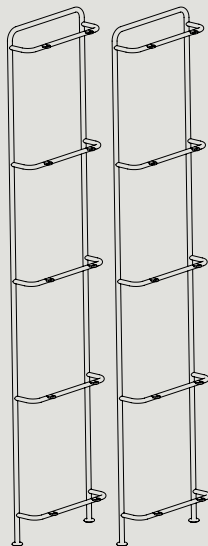

Safety precautions

WARNING! Furniture tipping over can lead to serious or fatal crushing injuries. The product must be mounted to the wall using the mounts provided.

- Dispose of plastic bag from packaging and do not allow children to play with it.
- Screws and plugs are not included to attach the wall mounts to the wall. Use suitable screws and plugs for your walls. Consult professional advice if in doubt.
- Do not put a TV on this product.
- Place heavier items on the lowest shelves.
- Maximum weight capacity 15 kg / 33 lbs per shelf.
- The shelving is only intended for indoor use.
- Handle with care in order not to scratch surfaces.
- Do not place the product in a humid environment.

Cleaning instructions

Lacquered wood

For daily care, it is recommended to dust the surface with a soft, dry cloth. Regular cleaning can be done using a soft cloth wrung in lukewarm water. Dry immediately afterwards with a soft, dry cloth following the wood grain.

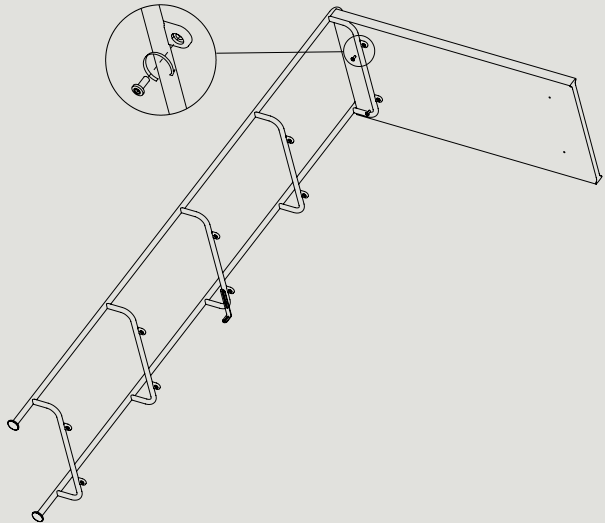
Avoid abrasive cleaning detergents and aggressive cleaning agents as they may damage the surface of the wood. To prolong the look and lifespan of lacquered wood, avoid placing in direct sunlight, excessive heat or humidity.

Chromed metal

It is recommended only to use a soft dry cloth to clean chromed surfaces but in case more severe cleaning is necessary, a soft cloth wrung in lukewarm water can be carefully applied. Always dry immediately after cleaning with a soft dry cloth. Avoid using abrasive cleaning agents as this may permanently damage the surface.

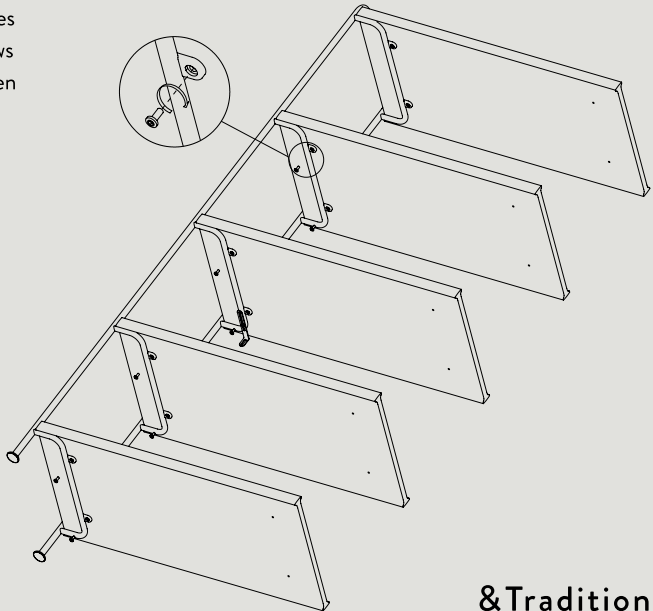
Step 1 / 12

Attach 1 shelf (A) to one of the frames (B) using 2 screws (C). Do not fully tighten the screws yet.



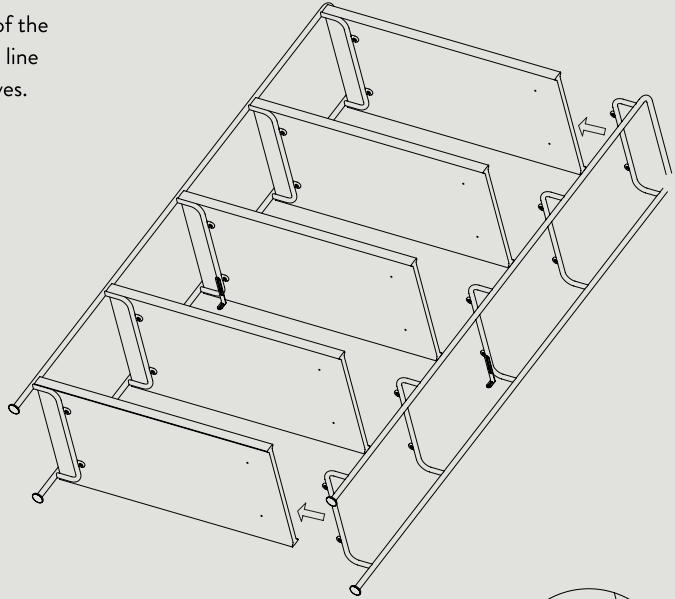
Step 2 / 12

Attach the rest of the shelves to the frame using the screws provided. Do not fully tighten the screws yet.



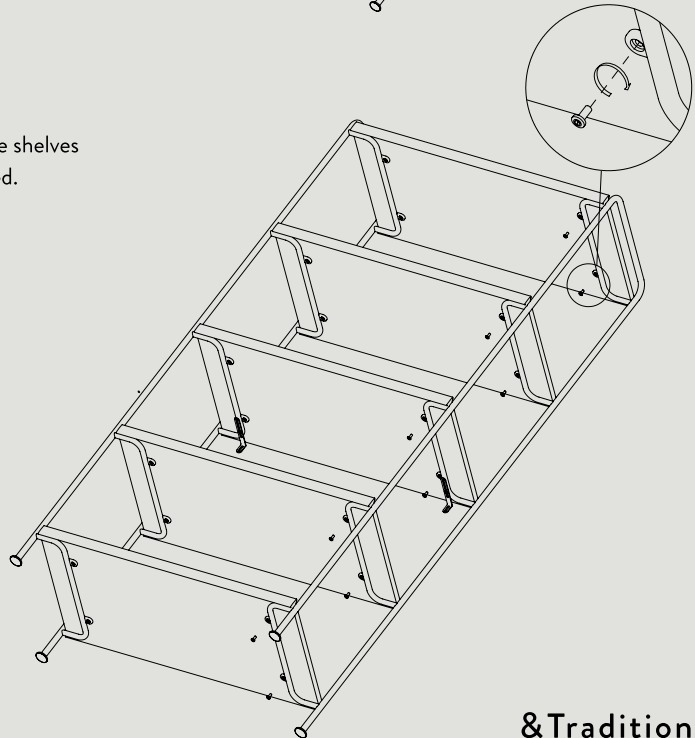
Step 3 / 12

Carefully align the holes of the second frame (B) to be in line with the holes in the shelves.



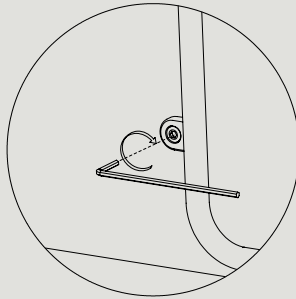
Step 4 / 12

Attach the frame to the shelves with the screws provided.



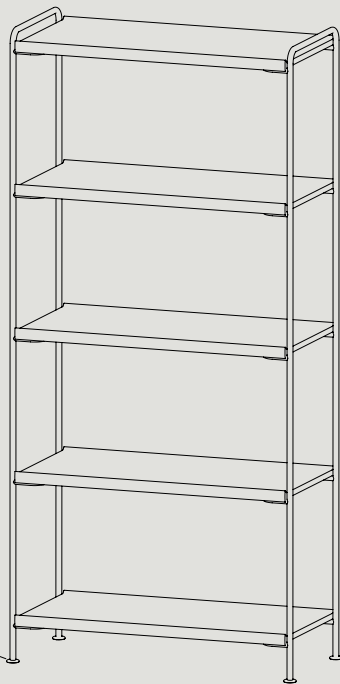
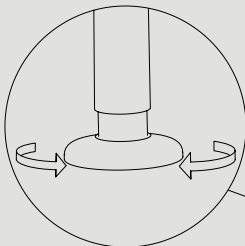
Step 5 / 12

Fully tighten all screws and carefully place the shelving in an upright position.



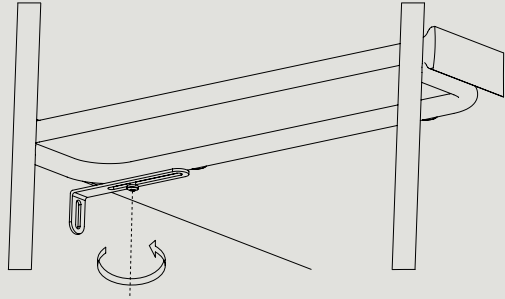
Step 6 / 12

Make sure the shelving is levelled. If not, adjust the gliders as needed.



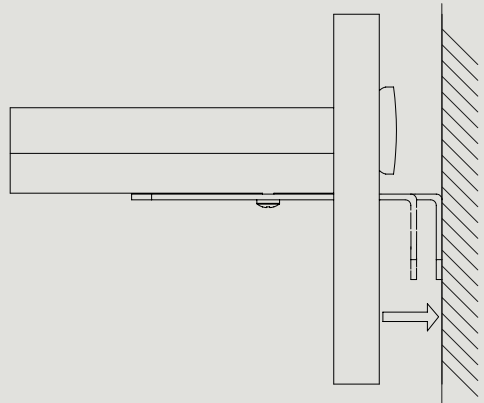
Step 7 / 12

Loosen the screws for the wall mounting brackets. (F)



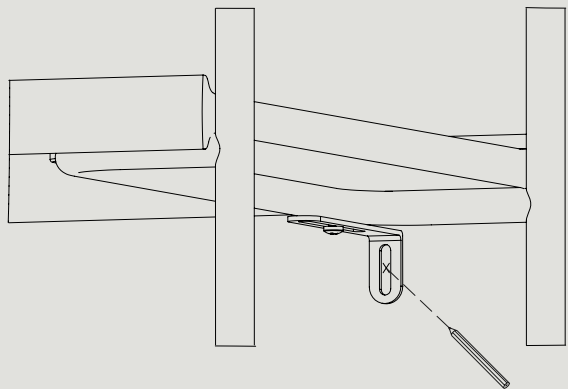
Step 8 / 12

Place the shelving next to the intended wall and push the wall mounting brackets to be flush with the wall.



Step 9 / 12

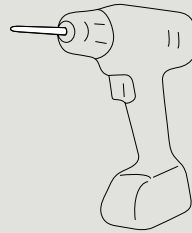
Mark the holes with a pencil on the wall.



Step 10 / 12

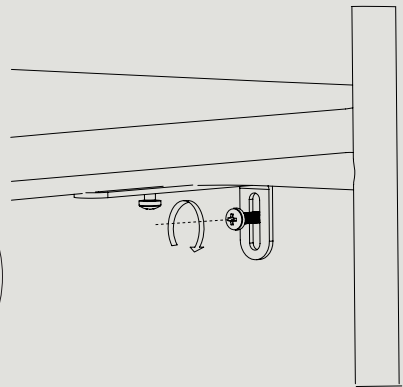
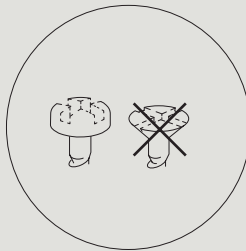
Drill the holes for plugs that are suitable for the type of wall.

IMPORTANT: Make sure that you use plugs suitable for your wall type. If in doubt, consult a professional to ensure the product is securely attached to the wall.



Step 11 / 12

Place the shelving next to the wall and secure it in place using a pan head screw.



Step 12 / 12

Tighten the screw on the frame to fully fasten the wall mounting bracket.
