TYPE CHAIR

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CAUTION / OUTDOOR FURNITURE

- The Type chair have a two component coating; a primer and an outdoor silicone coating which provides a barrier to corrosive elements making it suitable for outdoor use. It complies with the highest quality standards and is designed to last, making it ideal for both private and public environments
- The Type Chair are handcrafted and minor blemishes and imperfections may be visible.

These are not considered defects and do not interfere with the quality and function of the product.

- Always remove stains quickly before they can do any permanent damage to the furniture.
- Make sure to wipe off any sun cream or other liquids from the furniture after use, as these can leave stains on the surface if left in direct sunlight.
- Wipe off the furniture if it becomes wet after rain or snowfall as this will damage the surface over time.
- Wipe off bird droppings quickly as they may lead to permanent corrosion or staining.
- Please be aware that the product will always be naturally affected by the surrounding environment it is exposed to, and that a

certain amount of discoloration is to be expected.

- When you move your furniture, make sure you lift it rather than pulling or pushing it to avoid damaging the floor, legs and mountings.
- Avoid improper use such as sitting on the backrest or tilting the seats on their back legs, putting your feet on the furniture or standing on it.
- Be careful not to scratch or damage the surface with sharp objects.
- Avoid partially covering the surface, for example with tablecloths, cushions or place mats, as colour variances may appear.
- Minor spots of rust under the furniture and bases are considered as a natural result of general use and can be treated using the care instructions below.

- Direct placement on a seafront can lead to corrosion
- Stacking units. The stacking units are made of high-quality recycled nylon (PA6 Nylon) and are pre-mounted. If a stacking unit falls off make sure to remount it or contact your local retailer to buy replacements.
- Check the status of the gliders frequently and if worn down, contact your local retailer to buy replacements. The durability of the gliders will depend on the surface the chair is placed on.
- Take care not to scratch the chairs against each other when stacking them. Do not move or drag the chairs around when stacked as the weight will damage the legs.

CLEANING & CARE

SILICONE COATED ALUMINIUM


Wipe with a clean cloth wrung in water or in a solution of water and a neutral detergent. Remove soap residue immediately using a clean, dry cloth. Avoid using scouring cream, scouring pads or steel wool as it may scratch the surface. In the event of lime deposits on the surface use a clean, damp cloth wrung in lukewarm water with one part vinegar to nine parts water and avoid scrubbing as this may scratch the surface.


ENDCAPS

The endcaps are made of high-quality recycled nylon (PA6 Nylon). The durability of the endcap will depend on the surface that it is placed on. We recommend that you frequently check the status of the endcaps and if worn down, contact your local retailer to buy replacements.

STORAGE

The life expectancy of your furniture will vary depending on the weather and type of use. We recommend that you store it in a dry, ventilated place during winter and keep it protected from scratches and bumps.







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
